The Victorian Heart Centre- Alpine School Scholarship.

Available for students in Term 4
2001, 2002, 2003, 2004 and 2005.

The Alpine School is the innovator in residential education for students in middle school in Victorian Government Schools. The school is located at Dinner Plain, high in the Victorian Alps. The Victorian Heart Centre is an innovator in cardiology and thoracic medicine and is based at the Epworth Hospital in Melbourne. The two organizations have combined their talents and, thanks to the generosity of the Victorian Heart Centre, have made available a scholarship of \$1000 to enable a student to attend the Alpine School.



The Alpine School selects year 9 student teams from Victorian Government Schools on a region-by-region basis. Each term, Government secondary schools and colleges are invited to nominate teams of up to six students from each of a city and country region in the State education system. 45 students, boys and girls, can live, work and learn at the Alpine School for one term of usually 9 weeks. The school operates all year round, that is four terms a year.

The home school of students who are successful in their application to the Alpine School have made a commitment to contribute the normal fee of \$1000 for the experience of attending. This is recouped for many schools through a fee to the parents of attending students. Many schools also successfully seek assistance from voluntary and community based organizations in their home region. The scholarship will meet the full cost for an Alpine School experience for the successful student. Naturally, the full on-cost of a nine-week, fully residential experience is considerably more. The Victorian Department of Education, Employment and Training meets that cost through funding to the Alpine School.

Centre -Alpine School Scholarship

For a student to be eligible to apply for consideration for the Alpine School - Victorian Heart Centre Scholarship, the following criteria must be met:

- **Students need to be in year 9 at a State Education Secondary College, High School or Technical College.**
- **The Student's school must be in the region which is able to nominate a team for that term 4 period.**
- **The student's team must have successfully submitted an application to the Alpine School through the usual process. This is usually through a departmental regional office. Individual applications are unacceptable.**
- **The student must be a member of the team from the school that has been selected to attend the Alpine School in that term 4.**
- **The scholarship is not transferable and if for any reason the recipient of the scholarship cannot attend it will default to the next most eligible applicant.**
- **The Principal of the successful school team must endorse the scholarship application.**



The successful application will be ascertained through a collaboration with the Principal of the Alpine School and representatives of the Victorian Heart Centre through an open and transparent selection process.
